The end of the first grading period is coming up this month. The grading period will end on Friday, October 7th. Report cards will be sent home on Wednesday, October 12th.

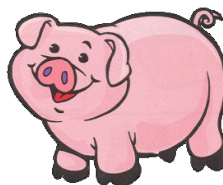
1ST GRADE VISION SCREENING
