- Winners of the Everton School Science Fair were:

- Ty McMullen received Honorable Mention for his project in the Regional Science Fair at Ball State University
- Everton's Science Team placed third in the state in competition.
- Everton's Math Team placed fourth in regional competition.
- Everton's Student Council raised over \$800.00 for Riley Hospital.
- Everton students had a 96.9% attendance rating during the 2015-2016 school year.
- Everton's kindergarten had a twenty-three percentage point increase in the number of students at the grade level norm for both Math and Reading on the Spring NWEA compared to the Fall NWEA.
- Everton's first grade had a ten percentage point increase in the number of students at the grade level norm for Reading on the Spring NWEA compared to the Fall NWEA.
- Everton's second grade had a fourteen percentage point increase in the number of students at the grade level norm for Reading on the Spring NWEA compared to the Fall NWEA.
- Everton 3-6 grade students scored above the district average at each grade level on Acuity Readiness C for Math.
